

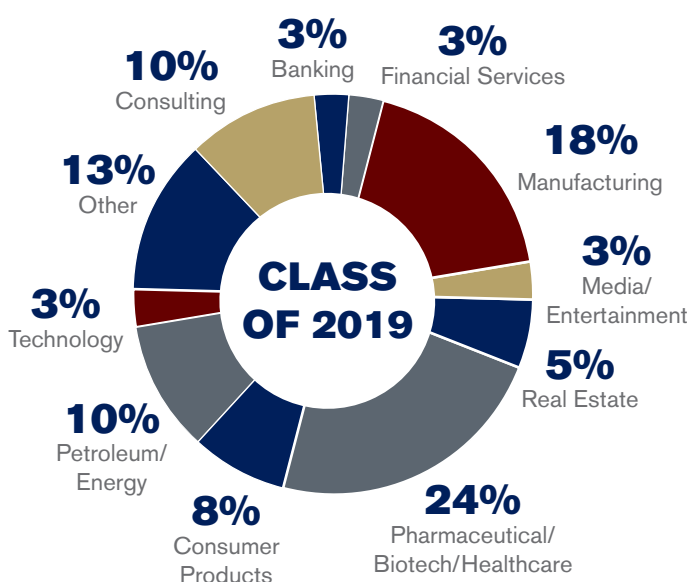

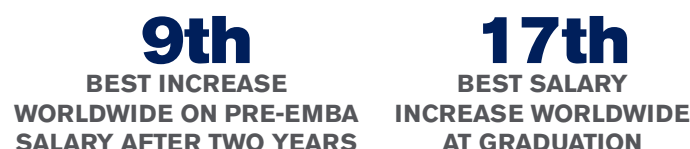

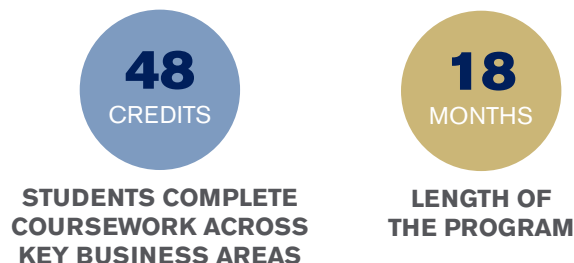

## ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

- Minimum of five years professional experience (10 is preferred)
- Experience in a managerial role
- Proficiency in English (TOEFL or IELTS)
- Application, two letters of recommendation, self-nomination letter, official transcript, and résumé



## ADMISSIONS DEADLINE

Admissions are made on a rolling basis. The next program launches in May 2019. The application deadline is April 16, 2019.

3rd round - February 3, 2019



## TUITION

Tuition is \$56,500 (USD). Tuition covers all courses, textbooks, study materials, hotel rooms, and group transportation in-country during Global Executive Forums. Tuition can be paid across five installments.
