## **Master Thesis**

25.000 - 30.000 words

Language: English (unless otherwise authorized)

Individual and independent research project based on a case study from their context, equivalent to 30 ECTS. This thesis must be based on the collected empirical data and demonstrate knowledge from the theoretical input gathered during the program and through personal research. The research process will begin with an initial proposal to be presented upon admission to the program. The research project will be developed in the course of the program by means of individual mentoring, peer review, and periodic updates. A final draft is expected by the final unit of the program.

# **Requirements for Application**

*Curriculum Vitae (CV):* presenting the academic qualifications as well as previous work experience in the fields of Interreligious Dialogue, Public Relations and Media, Constructive Conflict Management.

"Statement of Intent": explaining the future commitment to interreligious dialogue and conflict transformation.

Letter of recommendation from the Principal or a faculty member of the college/university/seminary in which the applicant completed his/her bachelor/master

degree providing information on the applicant's academic standard, achievement and ability to pursue the MA-RCT programme.

Letter of Recommendation from High Level Church Office (National, Diocese, District etc.) assuring that the church is willing to pay salaries during the 5 on-campus-phases which means leave from work for 5 months over a period of 2.5 years;

providing a reliable perspective that the student can make use of acquired competencies in the fields of Interreligious Dialogue, Public Relations and Media, Constructive Conflict Management in a future responsibility.

Study Proposal for the intended research project of not less than 2.000 words: It should be an individual and independent research project based on a case study from the applicant's context. It should relate to basic questions of interreligious dialogue, interculturality, and / or constructive conflict management.
